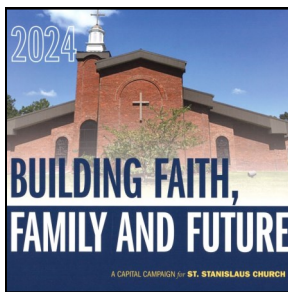
### Twenty– Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Saint Stans Parishioners:

Catholic Charities and the NC Knights of Columbus State Council are partnering to collect and deliver resources to the survivors of the terrible flooding in western NC. If you wish to assist, you can give a financial donation and/or donate specific items. The flyer in the parish bulletin includes a QR code and website for financial contributions, a list of specific items accepted by Catholic Charities, and the location of a local collection site for those items in Wilmington. Parishioners can take their donated items directly to the Catholic Charities' Wilmington location at 4280 US Hwy. 421N, Suite 110, on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9am – 2pm. To assist those parishioners unable to take their donations to the Catholic Charities location, the Knights of Columbus at St. Stans will be collecting those items at the parish hall 30 minutes before and after weekend Masses on October 19, 20, 26, and 27. Just look for the men in green shirts at the parish hall and they will be glad to assist you.
