St. Stanislaus has a Ministry of Visitation and Prayer. This is a team of parishioners who can visit the sick and some can also bring Holy Communion to them.

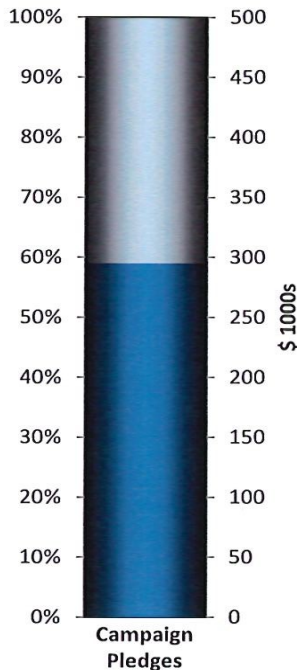

### **Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Like last Sunday, the Gospel Readings today tell us about Jesus...Jeremiah 31 describes Him as deliverer of his people bringing them back from the ends of the world. Psalm 126 tells us how He has done great things for us. Hebrews 5 reminds us how He is a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.
